GERMAN TOWNSHIP, CLARK COUNTY CEMETERY REGULATIONS

The following regulations have been designed for the mutual protection of the owners of interment rights within all German Township Cemeteries.

GENERAL REGULATIONS:

No boxes, shells, toys, artificial animals, rocks, ceramics, glassware, metal designs, wood items, baskets, ornaments, chairs, benches, money, or similar items are permitted to be placed on or around any grave, or elsewhere in the Cemetery.

No trees, flowers, shrubs, or plantings of any kind may be planted on or around any grave, or elsewhere in the Cemetery except by Township Cemetery personnel.

The Cemetery is not responsible for loss, theft or damage of personal property, including artifacts, or personal effects, etc. placed on or near internment spaces or elsewhere in the Cemetery.

SEASONAL CLEANUP DAYS AND DECORATION REGULATIONS:

SPRING CLEANUP	around March 15
WINTER CLEANUP	around November 15

<u>Winter decorations</u> are permitted from November 15 through March 15. All winter decorations will be removed during Spring Cleanup and disposed of by cemetery personnel.

<u>Spring decorations</u> are permitted between March 15 and November 15 only in vases that are a permanent part of the memorial. Fresh, silk, or plastic flowers are permitted. When flowers begin to show distress they will be removed. Due to the mowing season any decorations not in memorial vases will be removed at the cemeteries discretion.

Seasonal Decorations are allowed during these holidays:

EASTER FATHER'S DAY MOTHER'S DAY FOURTH OF JULY MEMORIAL DAY VETERAN'S DAY

Due to the mowing schedule, **decorations can only be placed on the graves 3 days prior to the holidays listed, and will remain in place for one week following the holiday**. After that time, decorations will be removed and disposed of by cemetery personnel.
